# NORTH CAROLINA ASSOCIATION OF MUNICIPAL CLERKS BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING DECEMBER 12, 1997

The NCAMC Board of Directors met in the Board Room at the North Carolina League of Municipalities on Friday, December 12, 1997 at 10:00 a.m. The Officers and Board Members in attendance were as follows: Sabrina M. ### CALL TO ORDER

President Sabrina M. Guy called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Janice Thomas made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 13, 1997, and the September 12, 1997 minutes. The motion was seconded by Sue Britt with the vote being unanimous.

### TREASURER'S REPORT
